Dynamic wrinkles and folds appear in areas of the face which move repetitively. RHA® is designed to be resilient enough to adapt to your facial movement, which may provide a more natural look at rest and in motion.

Your skin contains hyaluronic acid (HA), which provides moisture, volume and structure. **The RHA® Collection is intentionally made to be more like the natural HA in your skin.**

RHA® uses a gentle manufacturing process with few chemical modifications. This helps preserve the natural structure of the HA, allowing it to mimic the natural HA found in your skin.

The RHA® Collection developed by TEOXANE Laboratories in Geneva, Switzerland, represents the latest advancement in HA filler technology.

TEOXANE's founder, Valérie Taupin, was one of the original co-creators of Juvéderm® two decades ago and is one of the world's leading experts in beauty and aesthetics.

Madame Taupin recognized that traditional fillers did not meet all the demands of facial movement for a natural looking outcome. To create RHA®, she tasked her R&D team to develop a filler that was made differently – a resilient filler that moves seamlessly with the dynamic areas of the face.

RHA® Approved Use The RHA® collection of fillers is for injection into the facial tissue for the correction of dynamic facial wrinkles and folds that are moderate to severe, such as nasolabial folds, in adults 22 or older.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION Are there any reasons why I should not receive any RHA® injectable gel formulation? Do not receive if you have a history of multiple severe allergies or severe allergic reactions; if you are allergic to lidocaine or gram-positive bacterial proteins; or if you have a bleeding disorder.

What precautions should I discuss with my doctor? Tell your doctor if you are pregnant or breastfeeding as the safety of these products for use during pregnancy or while breastfeeding has not been studied. Tell your doctor if you have a history of excessive scarring, keloid formations or pigmentation disorders, as use of these products may result in additional scars or changes in pigmentation. Tell your doctor if you are planning laser treatments or a chemical peel, as there is a possible risk of inflammation at the treatment site if these procedures are performed after treatment. Tell your doctor if you are on immunosuppressive therapy used to decrease your immune response, as use of these products may result in an increased risk of infection. Tell your doctor if you are using medications that can prolong bleeding, such as aspirin, ibuprofen, or other blood thinners, as this may increase bruising or bleeding at the injection site. The safety and effectiveness of RHA® fillers in areas other than those indicated have not been established in US clinical studies. Patients who experience skin injury near the site of injection with this product may be at a higher risk for side effects. Minimize strenuous exercise, exposure to extensive sun or heat, and alcoholic beverages within the first 24 hours following treatment.

What are possible side effects? The most commonly reported side effects included injection-site redness, swelling, pain, tenderness, firmness, lumps/bumps, bruising, discoloration, and itching. One of the risks with using these products is unintentional injection into a blood vessel, and while rare, the complications can be serious and may be permanent. These complications, which have been reported for facial injections, can include vision abnormalities, blindness, stroke, temporary scabs, or permanent scarring.
