Eventually, during the treatment, the fat cell's membrane will rupture, leaving the cell unable to function accurately. Once this happens, the fat cell can no longer store fat and will then process out of the body as waste.

Fat reduction treatments, or surgical liposuction options, should not be confused with traditional weight loss programs. During weight loss, the fat cells will simply release the stored fat. 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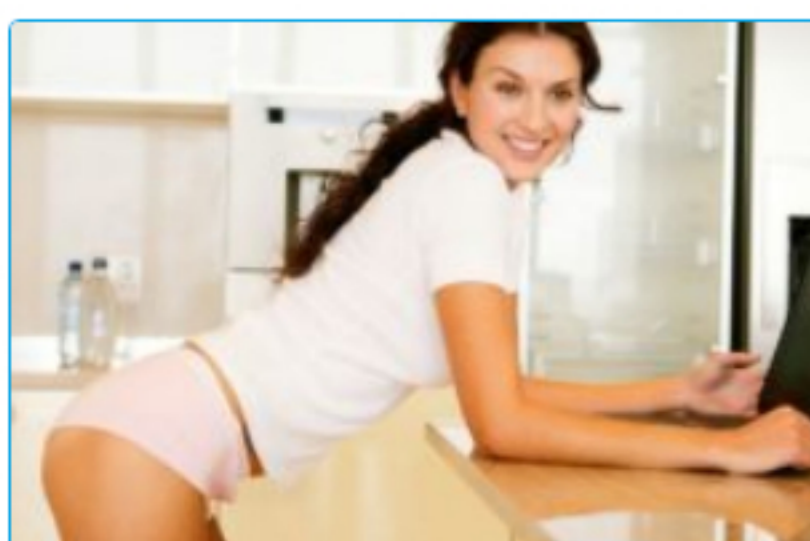


Ray Seballos, MD
