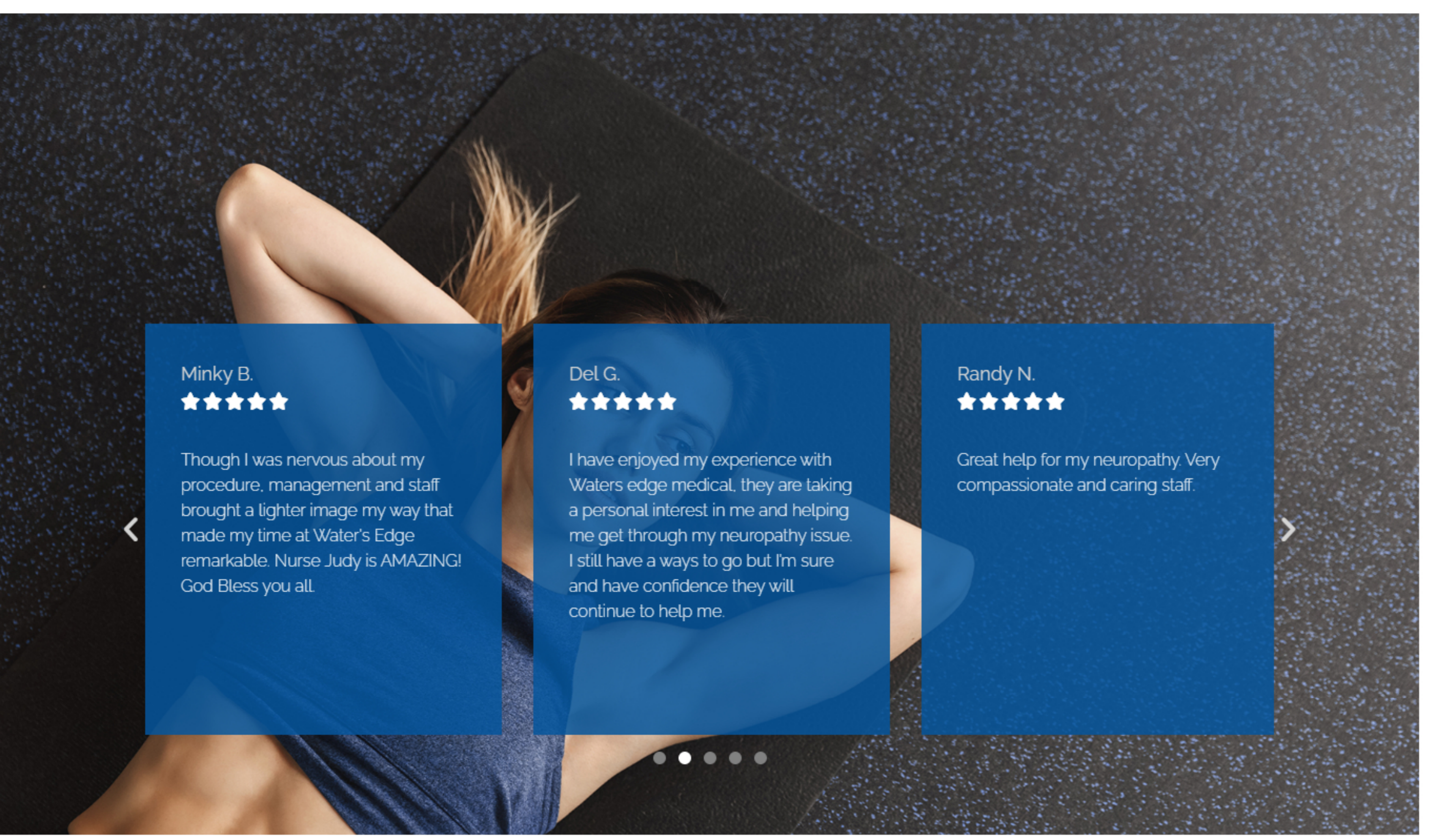
- ▶ Joint pain

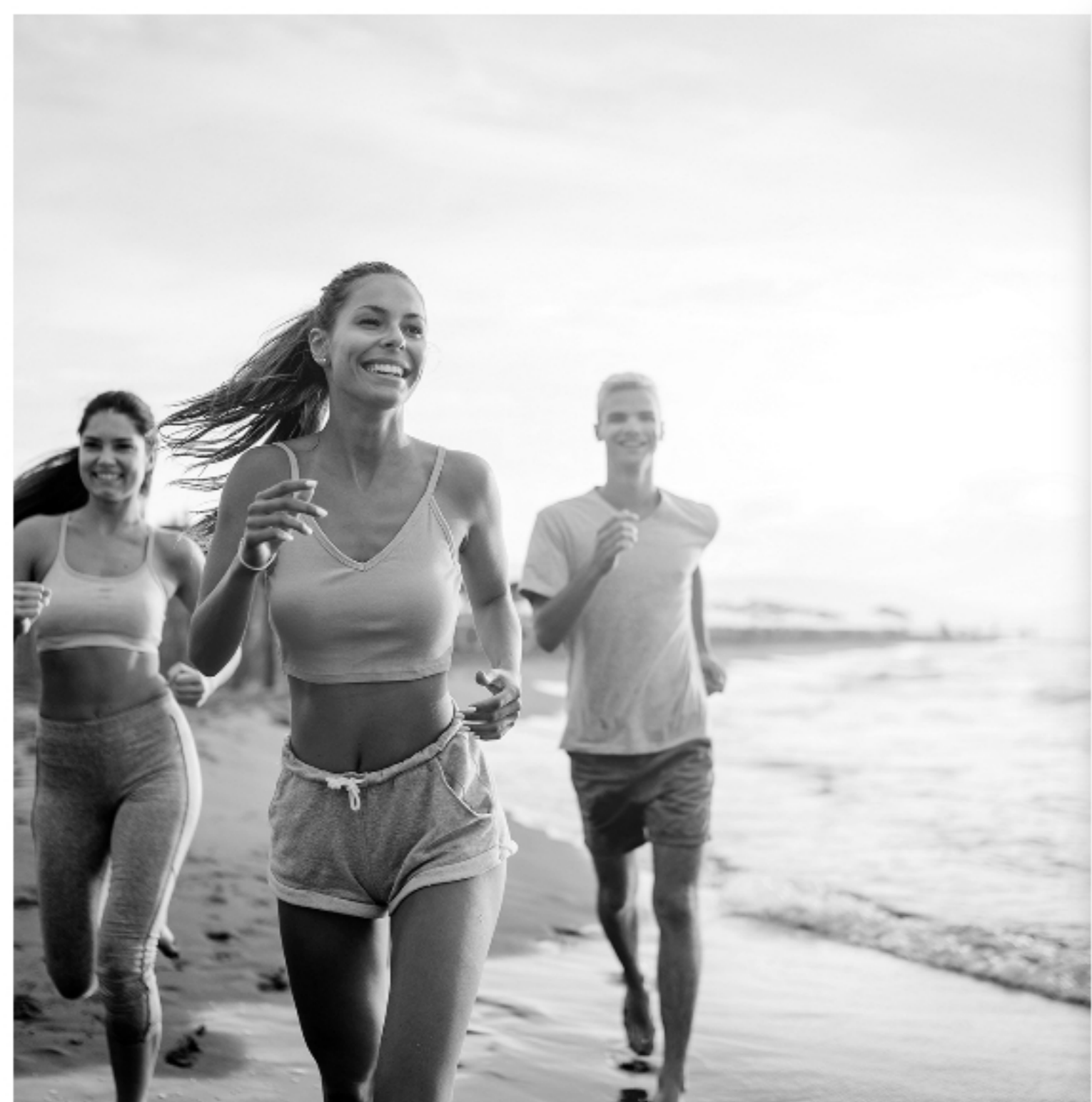

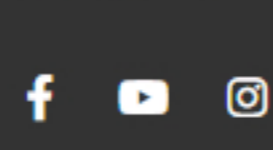
