Plasma therapy and Sciatica

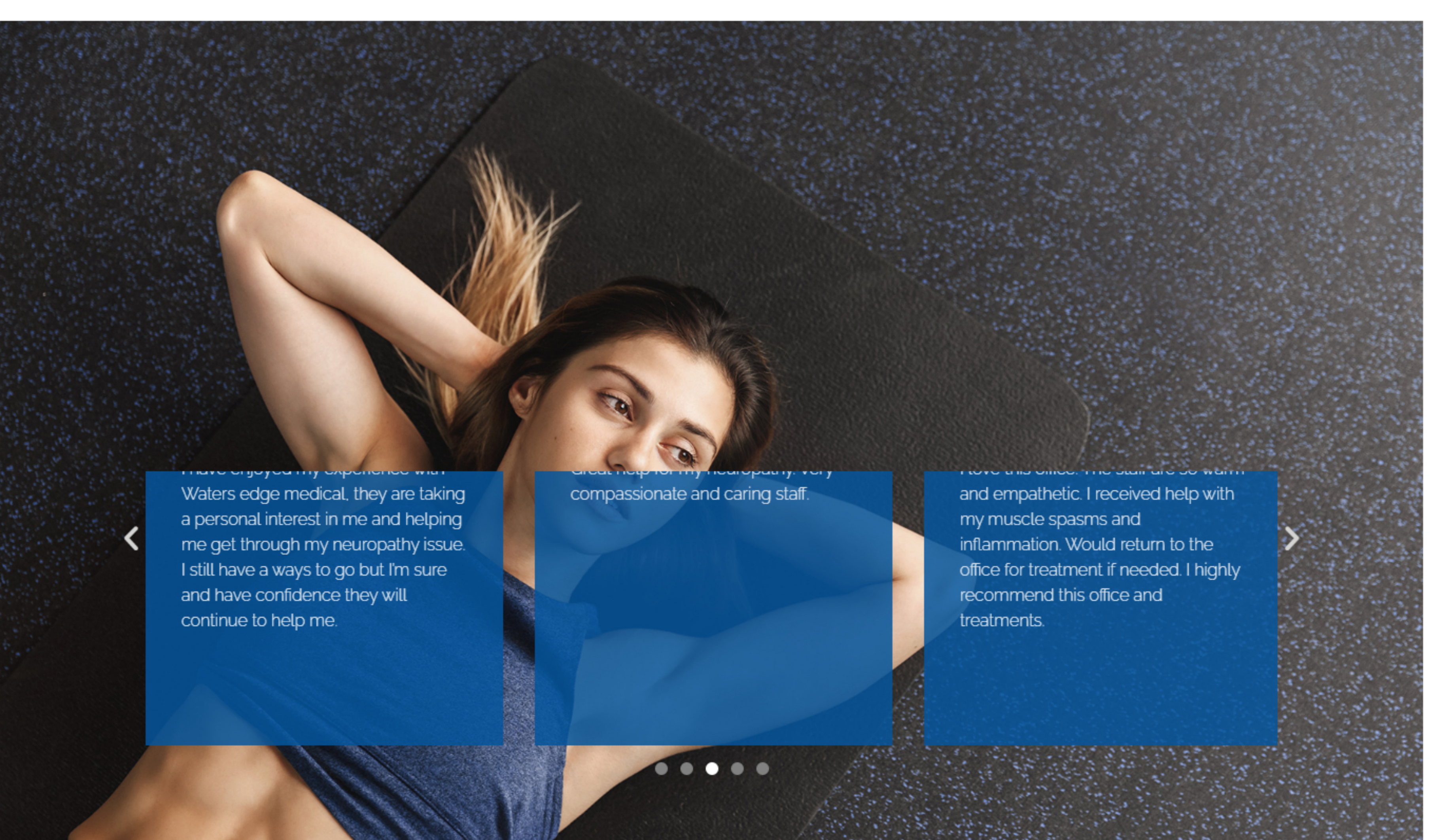

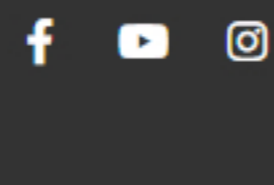
